




Meeting: September 11th – Investigating Concrete Failures

Jeff Varga is a Concrete Detective (Petrographer) with The Euclid Chemical Company. In his role, Jeff is tasked with analyzing concrete at a microscopic level to determine why concrete failed. Concrete Petrography is mainly utilized as a troubleshooting tool "post-mortem" and Jeff has seen his share of concrete crimes. He has spent 25 years sleuthing stones ever since receiving his BS in Geology from the University of Akron.


