Many of us have heard of The Esplanade project that is being planned for the North Side. Now we get to hear from one of the architects designing the project, Philip Wilkinson from AE7 Architects. And yes, a Ferris wheel is planned for the project as well as a splash park, marina, an ice-skating rink and housing.

Situated on the Ohio riverfront of Pittsburgh's North Side, Esplanade is a truly transformative development which turns abandoned industrial buildings into a new mixed-use waterfront district that situates residences, restaurants, retail, and hotels alongside the city's newest marina. Designed to extend the city's existing attractions, visitors can arrive by foot, bike, car, bus, or boat to stroll through the walkable, open spaces of this updated riverfront. The pedestrian-friendly neighborhood is also designed to be extremely livable, providing apartments with access to all amenities. *[description taken from AE7's website]*
Developers say the project is scheduled to break ground in 2023, with the first phase completed in 2026, but let's hear from the designer and developer on what is occurring in phases for this transformative project.
