Estimates show that within the next ten years, ninety percent of real estate development will involve adaptive reuse existing buildings in lieu of new construction. There are many contributing factors to this paradigm shift, but one key influence has been an increased awareness of climate change and its impact on our planet and its inhabitants. Hear Scott Bofinger and Jesse Gidley of LGA Partners discuss preliminary design considerations that evaluate the feasibility of adaptive reuse and the technical details to make it a reality. - Expansion Joints




